

#### **Getting started**

#### **Challenge:**

Assessments are complex, cover a variety of topics, scales, approaches, and knowledge systems and perspectives

Lesson 1 Define clear, policy relevant questionsLesson 2 Carefully plan and set clear boundaries of scope and scale

#### Maintaining a balance between all components

#### **Challenge:**

Ecosystem approach is multi-layered and complex: coordination and integration of all components, with well-balanced inputs and resource allocation is critical

#### **Challenge:**

Securing buy-in from stakeholders is difficult to get and difficult to maintain
